Gas Safety Practices for Fire Prevention:



Install and test natural gas alarms.




Keep smoke and carbon monoxide detectors up to date.



Have all fuel-burning appliances inspected annually.



Keep gas meters and piping clear of snow, ice, or clutter.



Know where your household gas shut-off valve is located.
